

MEDICAL & LEGAL RELEASE

RELEASE INDEMNITY & HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned parent/legal guardian of:

Authorize my son/daughter full participation in the Jones Soccer Camp at HBU, including all related camp activities. It is my understanding that participation in the activities at the Jones Soccer Camp at HBU is not without an inherent risk of injury.

In consideration of my son's/daughter's participation in the Jones Soccer Camp at HBU, I hereby release, waive, discharge, and agree not to sue the camp, the Athletic Department, coaching staff, Houston Baptist University, including without limitations, its officers, directors, trustees, employees, agents, students, and affiliates from any and all liability, claims, demands, action, and clauses of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may have been sustained by my son/daughter, whether caused by the negligence of the releases, or otherwise while participating in such activity, or in, or upon the premises where the activity is taking place.

I hereby give my permission for any emergency treatment or medical care by a physician, hospital medical facility that may be required, including transport, during the specific camp week that my son/daughter is in attendance.

In addition, I verify that my son/daughter is covered with a family health insurance policy.

Furthermore, I will be solely responsible for any and all costs of medical attention and treatment under my insurance policy, and understand that only secondary coverage will be provided by the Jones Soccer Camp at Houston Baptist University.

SOCCER CAMP FAQ'S

ARE THERE ANY DISCOUNTS OFFERED?

- Families with two or more campers will receive one \$25 discount for every camper after the first full paying camper.
- A team of 11 or more will receive a discount of \$25 for each camper. The team must register together or send in all 11 forms together.
- **Only one discount per camper will be applied**

WHAT IS THE CAMP REFUND POLICY?

- The deposit of \$100 (Residential) and \$50 (all other camps) are non-refundable. If a cancellation occurs prior to two weeks of camp starting there will be a full refund minus the deposit. If a cancellation occurs within two weeks of camp, regardless of the reason for the cancellation, 50% of any payments collected (minus the deposit) will be refunded. There are no refunds within 48 hours of a camp starting.
- **Returned checks** will be charged an additional \$35 fee.

WHAT FORMS ARE REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION?

- Completed Application (includes full payment), Medical & Legal Release form and medical history form. You will also need to provide a copy of your insurance card.

WHAT SHOULD CAMPERS BRING?

- Residential campers need to bring a ball, shin guards, cleats, running shoes, week's worth of soccer shorts, T-shirts and socks, twin size linens or sleeping bag, pillow, toiletries, alarm clock, sun screen, money for snacks and a bathing suit.
- Full day campers should bring a ball, shin guards, cleats, running shoes, sun screen and a lunch.
- Husky Pups should bring a ball, shin guards, cleats and sun screen.
- A camp T-shirt will be provided for all campers at every camp.

WHERE ARE THE CAMPS LOCATED?

- At Houston Baptist University soccer fields, on Fondren Rd. (just East of 59 and before you get to Beechnut).

WHERE AND WHEN IS CHECK IN?

- Residential camp check in will be from 3 to 5 pm on Sunday at the Men's Residence College (MRC).
- Full day and Husky Pups will check in on Monday from 8 to 9 am at the Houston Baptist soccer fields.

DO THE CAMPS OFFER GOALKEEPER TRAINING?

- Specialized goalkeeper training will be provided during each week of camp. Please indicate that you will attend goalkeeper training on your camp application.

WHAT MEALS ARE PROVIDED?

- Meals are only provided for the Residential Campers. Meals include breakfast, lunch and dinner. Commuters receive lunch and dinner.

ARE THERE MEDICAL STAFF AT THE CAMP?

- There will be athletic trainers at each session and in the dorms.

ROOM KEY CHARGES?

- All campers will be responsible for their personal items and keeping their rooms locked whenever they are not in them. Campers will be issued a key to their room to be returned at check-out. Campers will be charged \$50 for any lost keys. Campers will be charged for all damages to their rooms or to any campus property.

WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM THE CAMPERS?

- Campers are expected to act with respect for themselves, other campers, MRC, the staff and the campus of Houston Baptist University. Campers who cannot behave in a mature manner will be expelled from camp.

ROOMMATE PREFERENCES?

- We will do our best in keeping with the requests for specific roommates. To insure that you get the roommate you are requesting it would be best for the two campers to send in their applications together.

2010 H.S. BOY'S RESIDENTIAL CAMP

June 27 - July 1 • Ages: 14 - 18 • \$500/\$450

The Boy's Residential Camp is specifically designed to meet the needs of the serious male player who is competing at the high school, club, or ODP level. The camp is for high school boys age 14 years through 18 years (players entering high school through players beginning their freshman year of college). The players will be placed in groups based on their age and ability levels. The players will be challenged under the rigorous training of high level, collegiate coaches. These coaches will put the players in an intense training environment geared to prepare the player to compete at the men's collegiate level. The players will



be instructed on performing individual technical skills, tactical awareness and proper decision making and performing under pressure. The training environment will be highly competitive, simulating a college training environment. The players will also receive classroom instruction on the process of being recruited and how to find the right fit academically and athletically. The staff will provide the players with college planning tools to assist in the pursuit of a college or university.
